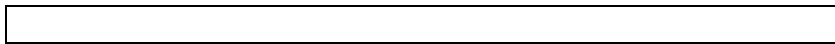

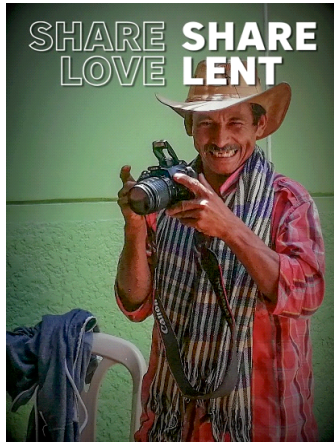
James Tissot The Merchants Chased from the Temple (1836-1906)
