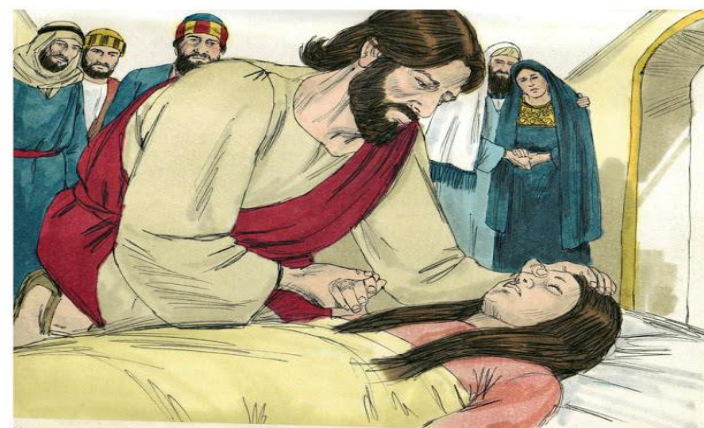

INVITATION -NOVENA AND ACT OF ENTRUSTMENT TO SAINT JOSEPH: As agreed by the Permanent Council of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops at its meeting of March 2021, and in solidarity with the Holy Father’s proclamation of a “Year of Saint Joseph”, we invite parishes and parishioners to celebrate an **Act of Entrustment to Saint Joseph, on Thursday, 1st July (Canada Day)**. Complying with COVID-19 restrictions, parishes may celebrate within the church itself or parishioners could offer the Act of Entrustment to Saint Joseph at home. The Act of Entrustment will be preceded by a Novena imploring Saint Joseph’s intercession for the welfare of the entire country, for the many needs of society, and to pray in particular for those who passed away due to COVID-19. The Novena will begin on Tuesday, 22 June and end on Wednesday 30 June.
