

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The finance/maintenance committee of our parish met during the week. Highlights of the meeting are:

- One Heart One Soul Campaign: Sincere thanks to everyone who
 has contributed or continue to contribute towards our parish project
 of accessibility. As we all know, COVID-19 considerably slowed
 things down in many sectors of our society, but our project is ongoing. We are contacting companies that will execute the project
 and we will continue to carry parishioners along as the project
 progresses. Again, thanks for your contributions.
- Church window frames: There was a visit recently by personnel from the Diocese of Hamilton and some parts of our Church needing urgent attention were pointed out. One of such are window frames around the Church and by the Church entrance which need new paint to protect the frame. To that end, anyone who knows a company/individual who can scrape the old paint and apply new paint should contact the parish office as soon as possible. We hope to do this before winter.
- Middle railing at the entrance of the church: It was noted that this hinders free movements during weddings and when caskets are brought into Church during funerals. As such, it was suggested that the middle railings be removed, and its rusted base be cleaned. The other two railings on both sides need to be cleaned also but they will remain in place.
