FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK 1st Sunday of Advent: Hope in Christ

I welcome everyone in our parish to the beginning of another liturgical calendar, year C, with our celebration of this first Sunday of advent. The central theme of today's celebration is "Hope". In a world filled with hopelessness on many fronts, God's words remind us that "Hope does not fail us because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us" (Rm. 5:5). Advent is a time of preparation for the that time when Christ who is the fulfilment of our hope will come among us as a little baby. Today, we light the first candle in our advent wreath. Everything in the wreath has deep spiritual significance: the circular nature of the wreath made up of evergreen leaves symbolizes God who has no beginning or end and who is ever present in our lives. There are three purple and one pink candles, known respectively as Prophetic, Bethlehem, Shepherd and Angel's candles. The candles stand for Hope, Faith, Joy and Peace. Let our preparation therefore take into account these advent symbols as we prepare for Christ's coming through a holy way of life, since the One we expect this Christmas charges us to be holy just as God is holy. This is what St. Paul encourages the Thessalonians and all of us to do in today's 2nd reading. Christ also tells us in today's Gospel to be vigilant in our preparation for the coming of the Son of Man in glory. This new year in our liturgical calendar invites us all to begin afresh with Christ. We can do this by inviting our brothers and sisters who may not have been in Church for some time to come worship with us again. May Christ find us ready when he comes.
