#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK Lenten Season and Parish Report, 2021

The 40 days of abstinence, prayer and almsgiving which begin on Ash Wednesday this week call us to evaluate our relationship with God and with one another. On Ash Wednesday, we will be reminded that we are dust and unto dust we shall return. This truth about our existence invites us all to a more personal relationship with Christ through active participation in Church activities. We shall be having Stations of the Cross every Friday of Lent by 7pm. This is an opportunity for us to journey with Christ in his suffering so that he, in turn, may be our companion in the different stages of our life. Our Sunday Eucharistic celebration remains the core of our Christian life. It is important that we translate these religious activities including daily attendance at Mass, into our everyday life so that at the end of Lent, we may give an excellent report of ourselves to Christ who calls us to holiness of life. Just as this season is about report-giving, I am pleased to present our parish report for the year, 2021. It was a challenging year on account of covid-19 pandemic, but we thank God who saw us through that year. Last year, many persons in our parishes were admitted to various sacraments. At St. Mary, 4 persons were baptized, 24 received 1st Holy Communion, 16 received confirmation, the sacrament of the sick was administered to some at home and in the hospital and 3 couples were wedded in our parish. 3 members of our parish were called to their eternal reward. We pray that perpetual light will continue to shine on them and for God to console their loved ones. In St. Martin, 1 infant was baptized, the sick and homebound were also visited and there was one graveside service. As society opens up at this time, I encourage our parishioners who have not been in Church for some time to come back home. The bible says, "I was glad when they say to me, let us go into the house of the Lord" (Ps. 122:1). May we continue to draw strength from one another, and may God bless us as we worship Him as one family in Christ Jesus. Finally, on behalf of our parish Finance committee, I present our financial report for the year 2021 which is inserted into this week's bulletin. The financial report gives us an opportunity to see how we fared in 2021 compared to 2020 and where we need to make improvements in 2022. May God continue to bless us as we support our Church with our talents, time and treasure. Amen
