Next Sunday is Palm or Passion Sunday. It is the beginning of Holy Week. Christ underwent the passion, crucifixion, and death on the Cross for us all. What does this demand of us? Writing about this day many centuries ago, St. Leo the Great (Pope) says, "True reverence for the Lord's passion means fixing the eyes of our heart on Jesus crucified and recognizing in him our own humanity ... who cannot recognize in Christ his own infirmities? Who would not recognize that Christ's eating and sleeping, his sadness and his shedding of tears of love are marks of the nature of a slave"? Let us therefore prepare ourselves for the great celebration of the Holy Week by not only waving palm branches but more importantly by opening our hearts so that Christ, the Son of David and Prince of Peace may find a home in us. He took our nature to become one like us in all things but sin, now he wants us to take up his own divine nature through a life of holiness. Due to the procession we will be having before our Masses next weekend, we are encouraged to be in Church at least 10 minutes before start of Mass both on Saturday and Sunday. May the King who rides on a donkey find us worthy to reign with him in his kingdom of joy, peace and love.
