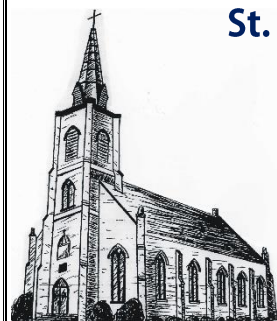

VIRTUAL BAKE SALE

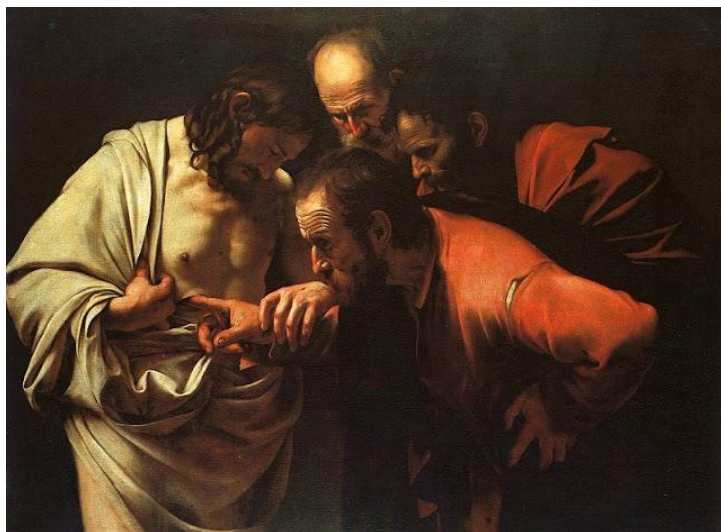
