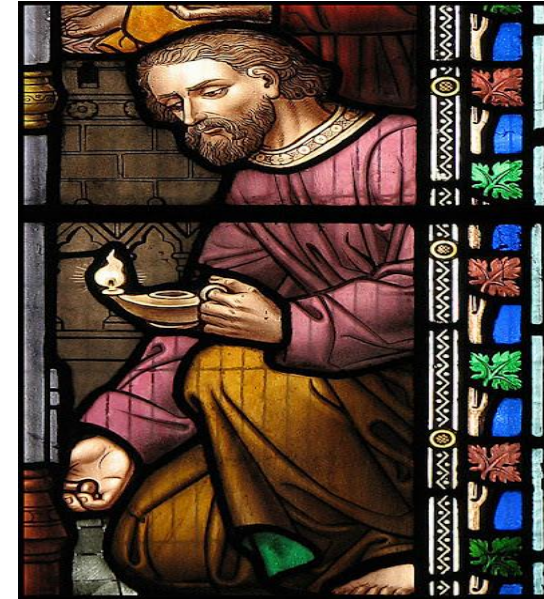
## C.Y.O. CAMP BREBEUF SUMMER EMPLOYMENT
