#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Although Advent is not a penitential season in the way that Lent is, it is still a time that calls forth in us works of penance. With the exception of the third Sunday, the clergy wear purple vestments. We do not sing the *Gloria*. And we learn from Isaiah and John the need to do penance to prepare for Christ.

Traditionally, the Church has observed three "Ember Days" during Advent as penitential days of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving. If the Ember Days were still in the calendar, they would fall on this Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday.

I would encourage you in this final stretch of Advent to resist the tide of our secular culture that has no use for this season. It wants to have a feast without a fast. Instead of feasting now, let's do penance together and so prepare our hearts to meet Christ when he comes.
