Thursday (Feast of the Chair of St. Peter): 1 Peter 5:1-4; Matthew 16:13-19

Friday: Ezekiel 18:21-28; Matthew 5:20-26

Saturday: Deuteronomy 26:16-19; Matthew 5:43-48
