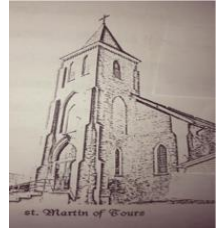

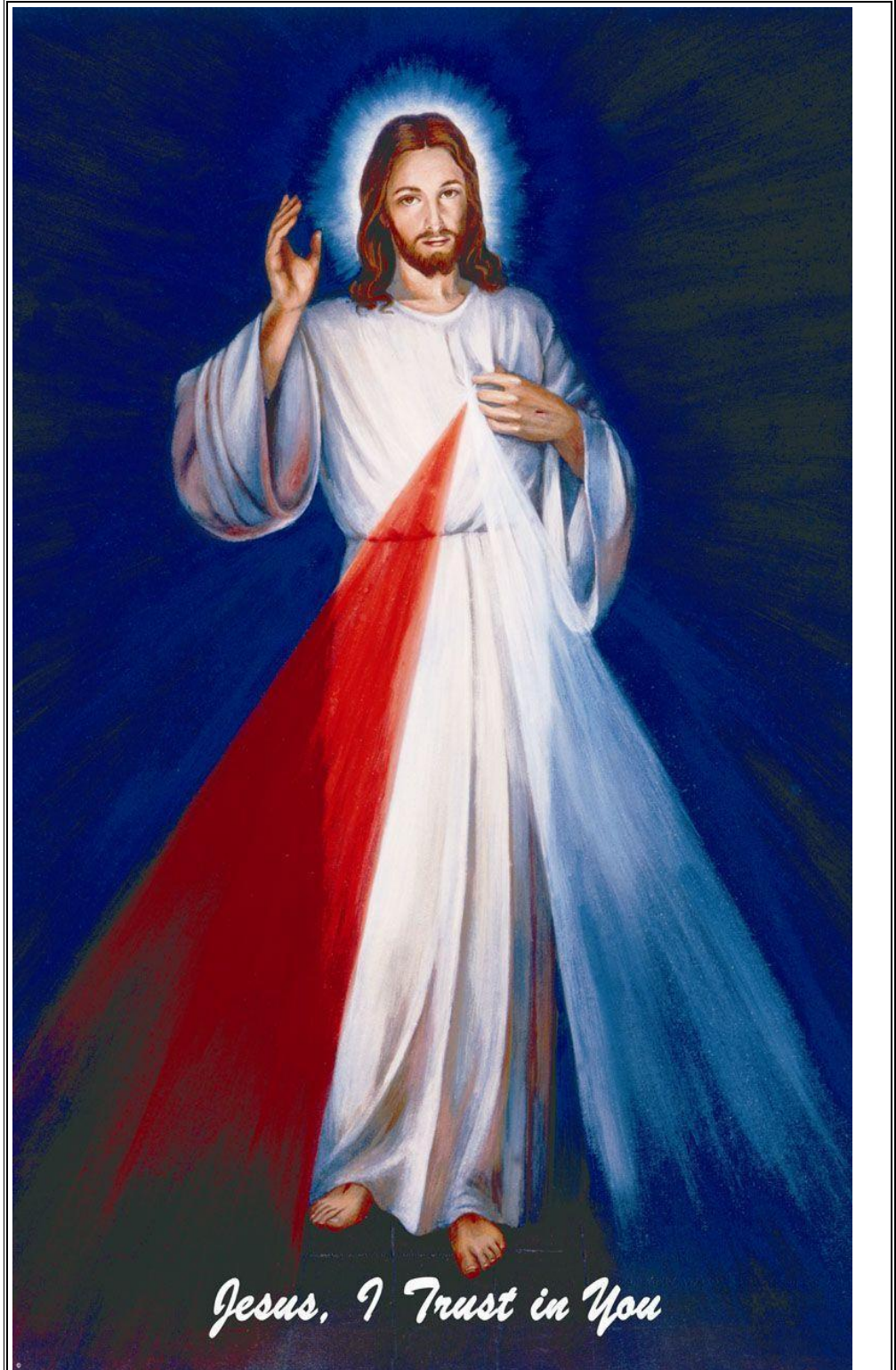

MOMENTS OF SILENCE DURING THE LITURGY

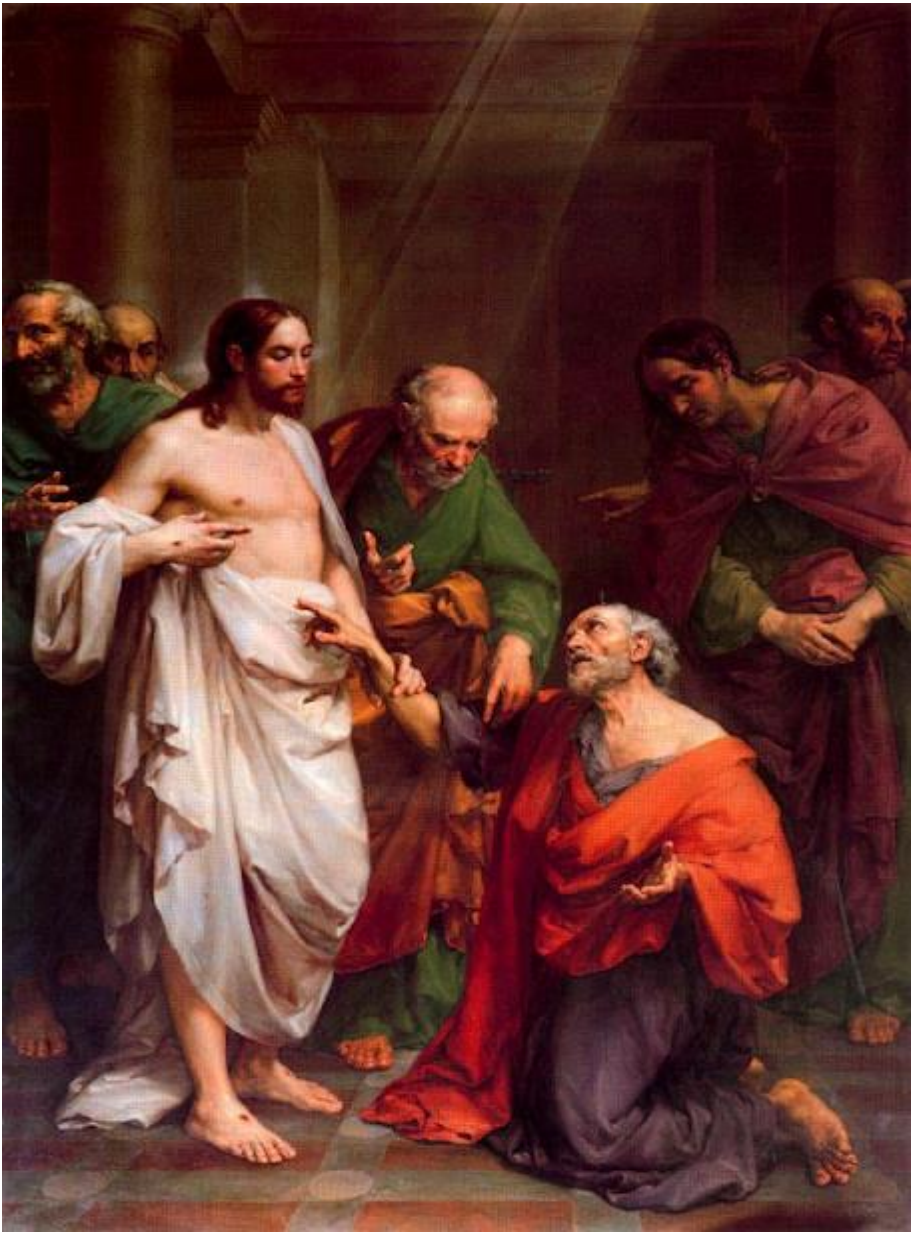
During the celebration of Mass, we have opportunities for prayerful silence. Before the Collect, the priest says, "Let us pray" and we all silently bring our own prayer intentions to the Mass. These intentions are then all collected and offered in the prayer said by the priest and confirmed by the "Amen" of the faithful. (For this reason, there is no need for us to silently pray for our own intentions during the General Intercessions.) After the readings, there should be a pause for silent meditation on the word of God that has been proclaimed. And before the Prayer After Communion, we have time to silently thank the Lord Jesus for participation in his Body and Blood and to pray that it will bear good fruit in our lives.
