


Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Bishop Crosby has designated October as the diocesan month of prayer for vocations.

It is good for us to pray for young people so that they may hear and respond to the vocation to be saints and to pursue holiness in the way God calls them to do so (whether in holy matrimony, holy orders, religious life, etc.).

Throughout the diocese a prayer for vocations will be offered at the end of Sunday Mass. This is different from the prayer we offer for seminarians. To simplify things, we will omit the prayer before Mass and pray the more general prayer at the end.

During October the prayers of the faithful will also be crafted to reflect the focus on vocations. It is possible that our usual petitions for the sick and deceased may be omitted one or more Sundays. Be assured that this is only a temporary change.

Finally, please pray the Rosary for vocations. There will be a public praying of the Rosary in St. Mary's Church at 11:00 a.m. over the course of three Saturdays: the 12<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, and the 26<sup>th</sup>. On Tuesday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> the 9:00 a.m. Mass will be celebrated in St. Martin's Church for the anniversary of the dedication of the church, with the Rosary following. Yours in Christ,


