


INDULGENCES

Between November 1st an 8th, a plenary indulgence is granted to the faithful who go to a cemetery and pray for the dead. The indulgence can only be applied to souls in Purgatory. An indulgence can be obtained each of the eight days that a cemetery is visited. The usual conditions apply:

- Intention to receive an indulgence.
- Being in a state of grace and detached from sin.
- Receiving the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation (can be several days before/after)
- Receiving Holy Communion.
- Praying for the Pope's intentions.


