



## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Monday, October 7 marks one year since the start of the current war in the Middle East. What started as a horrendous attack by Hamas against Israel has grown into a larger conflict, as more nations are now involved. It is lamentable that so many peoples are being affected by war. And I know that many fear that the war will continue to spread to other nations.

But October 7 is also the day when we celebrate the Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary (also known as Our Lady of Victory). We remember that the faithful praying of the Rosary has resulted in much good in recent centuries.

When the Blessed Virgin appeared to the children at Fatima, she said that, if they wanted peace, they should pray the Rosary. That was in 1917, during World War I, which ended the next year.

Aware of the situation in the Middle East and (even more so) the power of the Rosary, Pope Francis has called upon all the faithful to pray the Rosary this Monday, as well as to fast. I likewise encourage you to pray the Rosary for peace and to join that prayer with fasting or other acts of self-denial.
