



ANNOUNCEMENTS FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It is a pious custom to prepare for important feasts with a novena: reciting specific prayers for nine days before the feast.

Offering a novena helps us to grow in eager anticipation for that feast. It is also an opportunity to pray earnestly for a particular intention, which we can include in the novena.

The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary usually falls on December 8. However, since that is a Sunday in Advent this year, it is transferred to December 9.

To honour the truth that Our Lady was conceived without original sin, I encourage you to observe a novena from November 30 until December 8. An easy way to do so is to pray a Memorare each day for a particular intention.

Before each Mass during this period, we will recite the Memorare, uniting our intentions in a prayer to the Immaculate Virgin.

If you are unfamiliar with the Memorare, you can find the text here:

Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help, or sought thine intercession was left unaided. Inspired by this confidence, we fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, our mother. To thee do we come; before thee we stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not our petitions but in thy mercy hear and answer us. Amen. In Christ,
