


FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace be with you.

In his book *Jesus of Nazareth*, Pope Benedict XVI writes about how the feasts of the Old Testament were three-fold celebrations: they were tied to the yearly cycle, to a remembrance of the history of Israel, and they looked forward to realities to come in the time of the Christ.

There was a feast of Pentecost in the Old Testament. It was a festival that celebrated the grain harvest. It also was a celebration of the giving of the Law to Moses. But that celebration only looked forward to the true Pentecost to come after the resurrection of Christ.

In the true Pentecost, which we celebrate today, we celebrate the true harvest: the fact that the Holy Spirit unites many souls to the Church through the preaching of the Gospel and through Baptism.

We celebrate as well, the fact that the New Law is given. It is not a law written upon stone, but upon our hearts. The New Law is the grace of the Holy Spirit given to us.

As we celebrate Pentecost, let us remember and give thanks to God for his mercy in gathering us into his Church. And let us seek from the Holy Spirit hearts like unto Christ's own Heart: meek, humble, chaste, and merciful.


