



FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

May the peace of Christ be with you.

This year marks the 1700th anniversary of the First Council of Nicea.

It was at this great council of bishops that the Nicene Creed was first formulated. It was expanded at a later council to be almost exactly the same as the Creed we recite during the Eucharist today.

The fathers of the council composed this creed primarily to express our faith that the Son is truly divine. The Son is eternal (begotten before the ages, not created). He is "God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God". He is consubstantial with the Father (i.e., the Son is one only God with the Father - see: *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, para. 242).

It is a great gift to have this Symbol of Faith to give us a language to think and speak about who Christ is. May God grant that we may always love this faith and profess it until the end!
