


FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace be with you.

In the month of September, our eyes turn toward the Cross of Christ. This is in large part due to the celebration of two feasts: the Exaltation of the Cross (Sept. 14) and Our Lady of Sorrows (Sept. 15).

It is easy to forget how horrible the cross would have seemed in ancient times. It was a means of execution so horrid that it was never given to Roman citizens.

Many people at the time had a hard time believing in a crucified Christ. St. Paul says that the thought of this was a stumbling block for many Jews. To many Gentiles it seemed absurd. But to those who receive the call to faith, the power and wisdom of God is seen in Christ crucified (1 Corinthians 1:22-24).

In his *Summa Theologiae*, St. Thomas Aquinas asked and answered the question: "Whether Christ ought to have suffered on the cross?" He gave seven reasons it was fitting. I will not reproduce all seven but will share the first: to give us an example of virtue.

Aquinas quotes St. Augustine, who wrote, "God's Wisdom became man to give us an example in righteousness of living. But it is part of righteous living not to stand in fear of things which ought not to be feared. Now there are some men who, although they do not fear death in itself, are yet troubled over the manner of their death. In order, then, that no kind of death should trouble an upright man, the cross of this Man had to be set before him, because, among all kinds of death, none was more execrable, more fear-inspiring, than this."
