


#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany, I would like to take this opportunity to reflect briefly on the gifts of this major feast. As St. Matthew tells us, the wise men offered to Jesus gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.

St. Gregory the Great - an ancient pope and doctor of the Church - found great significance in these gifts. Christ receives gold, for he is King. He receives frankincense for he is God. He receives myrrh, (a spice used, among other things, for embalming corpses) for he will die for the sins of mankind. But St. Gregory also sees in these three gifts lessons for the kinds of gifts we should present to Christ to celebrate his birth: "To a king at his birth we offer gold, if we shine in his sight with the light of wisdom; we offer frankincense, if we have power before God by the sweet savour of our prayers; we offer myrrh, when we mortify by abstinence the lusts of the flesh." As we celebrate the Epiphany, and the gifts Christ has given us - especially that of faith in him - may we make a gift of ourselves to him by living sober, upright, and godly lives in this world (Titus 2:12)
