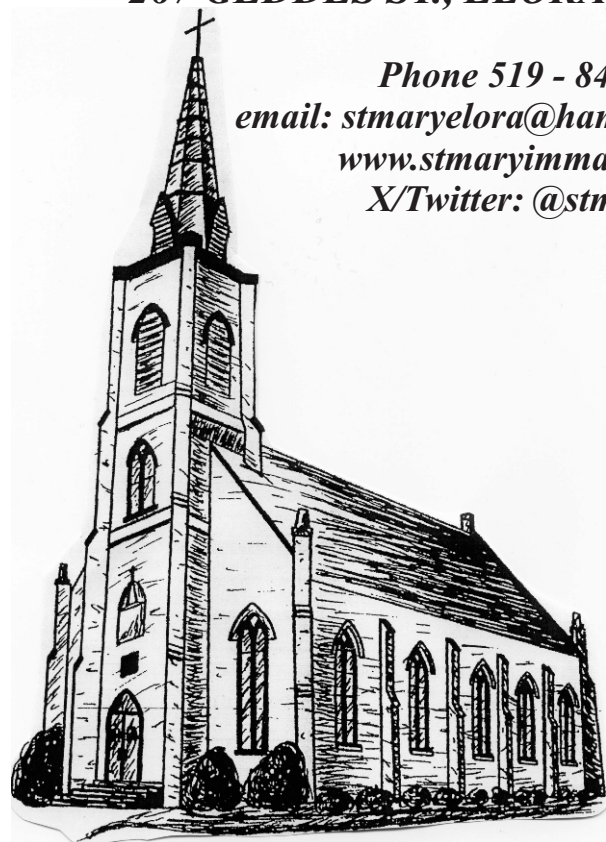

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace be with you.

This Sunday is known as the Sunday of the Word of God. It is a day when we should be ever more aware of the privilege of having access to the written Word of God, which we know as the Holy Bible.

The fourth century persecution of the Church under Emperor Diocletian involved - among other things - the public burning of Scriptures. Many brave saints violated the imperial edict and hid the Scriptures from the civil authorities.

Even today there are countries that persecute the Church and either completely ban or place heavy restrictions on distribution of the Holy Bible. Faithful Christians secretly possess and distribute the Scriptures in defiance of the civil authorities.

Perhaps we will see such days ourselves. In late 2025, one prominent Member of Parliament - speaking in committee - named three books of the Bible which - in his view - contain hate speech.

May the grace of Christ make us not only believe what is contained in Sacred Scripture, but also love, guard, and defend the written Word of God!

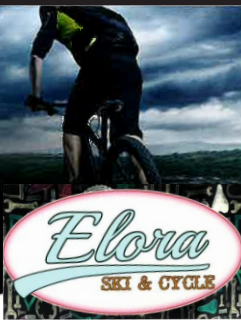
